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Barberton Announces 2019 Street Resurfacing Program

The City of Barberton is pleased to announce that this year's Street Resurfacing Program is set to commence on or about April 25, 2019. Barbicas Construction Co., Inc. out of Akron, Ohio, was selected as the contractor for the program via a publicly submitted bid that was unanimously approved by Barberton City Council.

This year's program includes a selection of both arterial and residential streets. Street selection is based on several factors, including input from City of Barberton staff, Barberton City Council representatives, citizens, and the City's engineering consultant, GPD Group.

"We continue to address street resurfacing within our community thanks to our residents and the passage of Issue 8." stated Barberton Mayor William B. Judge. "With this year's program, we will add to the 78 lane miles of roadway that have already been resurfaced through this funding since 2014."

Issue 8 funding was also the key driver in the City's pursuit and award of \$8.8 million in Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) competitive grant dollars that will see the completion of numerous arterial street enhancements, which are scheduled to start construction in fiscal year 2021.

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
