I wanted to give everyone an update on the status of the due date for City taxes. It was announced that the Federal Government is pushing back the due date for Federal taxes for individuals and businesses from April 15th to July 15th for this year.

With the Federal Government announcing the deadline being pushed back, residents and businesses of Barberton do not have to file their City taxes until July 15th as well. I am still working with CCA to get all of the remaining Tax Payer Assistance dates rescheduled in May, June, and/or July to help as many citizens file before July 15, 2020 as possible, but I will not have those dates until this pandemic is contained.

If you do not want to wait to file your taxes, you can do them at CCA's website (<http://ccatax.ci.cleveland.oh.us/>). If you do not want to do them online, you can also mail your tax documents to CCA along with your phone number, and CCA will process your tax return for you. CCA's mailing address is as follows:

If you have a completed city tax return form, you can either mail your completed form into CCA at the address above or drop it off at the Finance Department's Drive-Thru window, which we will then forward onto CCA.
