The American Rescue Plan Act was signed into law on March 11, 2021 and is a \$1.9 trillion plan providing funding in response to the COVID pandemic. The American Rescue Plan Act's State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund is a community stimulus plan administered by the U.S Treasury, providing \$350 billion in emergency funding for state, local, territorial, and Tribal governments.

The allowable use of these funds include:

- **Support public health expenditures**, by, for example, funding COVID-19 mitigation efforts, medical expenses, behavioral healthcare, and certain public health and safety staff
- **Address negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency**, including economic harms to workers, households, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector
- **Replace lost public sector revenue**, using this funding to provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the pandemic
- **Provide premium pay for essential workers**, offering additional support to those who have and will bear the greatest health risks because of their service in critical infrastructure sectors
- **Invest in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure**, making necessary investments to improve access to clean drinking water, support vital wastewater and storm water infrastructure, and to expand access to broadband internet.
