Re: Face Covering Requirements in City of Barberton Facilities


The COVID-19 Pandemic has been ongoing since March of 2020 and now is further complicated by aggressive and highly contagious variants of the virus.

To protect employees and members of the public who are present in City buildings from risk of spreading and contracting COVID-19 and its variants, it is necessary to implement a policy regarding use of face coverings by City employees and members of the public.

## POLICY

1. All City employees are to wear a face covering while at work and in any public area of the building or when interacting within their work space with co-workers and where appropriate distancing (of at least 6 feet between each person) is not possible.
2. Face coverings need not be worn if working alone in a contained work area.
3. All members of the public entering a City building are required to wear a face covering upon entrance and for the duration of their time in a City building.
4. If an employee or member of the public has been advised, by their physician, that a face covering is not medically advisable, they shall be exempt from the requirement.
5. This order shall take effect Tuesday, August 10, 2021.
